OPTIONS #2 Indicate through email that you are coming and send Etransfer payment as above or bring Cash or Cheques along with form the first night. Due to the restriction on number of skaters, we need firm commitment that the skater is going to participate.

WAIVERS: **ALL** waivers included in this registration package must be completed and sent with your registration or the skater **WILL NOT BE ALLOWED** on the ice until received. Covid waivers are for **ALL** skaters and Rowan's Law is for Starskaters only.

FEE STRUCTURE

- Fees may be paid in 2 equal payments indicated on the registration form.
- Please date any cheques for the 10th of the month
- There is a \$40.00 fee for returned cheques

REFUND POLICY

- The club must be notified in **writing** by Friday October 16 2020 for Fall session cancellation of registration. Please note that the \$50.00 Skate Canada Fee is non-refundable. This cost has already been added into the registration fees.
- There is no refund after these dates except for medical reasons and a Doctor's note is required.
- There is no refund of fees or prorating of fees if you are going to be away for holidays
- There is no refund for weather related cancellations as we do endeavor to not cancel unless the City of Cambridge closes their facilities.

1. I/We acknowledge that the World Health Organization has classified the Coronavirus Disease ("**COVID-19**") outbreak as a global pandemic and am/are aware of the risks of COVID-19. I/We specifically acknowledge and agree that I am/we are aware of the risks to personal health, including by the failure to follow physical distancing protocols, flowing from COVID-19, and that I am/we are assuming, on my own behalf and, if signing on behalf of a participant under 18 years, on their behalf, all health risks and adverse health related consequences caused by or arising from engaging in any Activities (the "**Assumed Risks**").
2. I/We acknowledge that the Organizers are implementing the **Skate Ontario Return to Play Protocols** ("**Protocols**") the most recent version of which will be posted from time to time on Skate Ontario's website. I/We specifically acknowledge and agree that I am/we are aware of Protocols, that I/we will abide by the Protocols, and that the Protocols are subject to all federal, provincial and municipal laws, regulations, by-laws and orders as they may exist from time to time.
3. I/we hereby release the Organizers, their members, officers, directors, employees, independent contractors, agents, and volunteers ("**Releasees**") from all liability, recourse, proceedings, claims, and causes of action of any kind whatsoever, in respect of all damages, personal injuries, death, or property losses which I/we may suffer arising out of or connected with the Assumed Risks, the content or implementation of the Protocols (including without limitation the conduct of any screening of any individual), and the preparation for, or participation in, the Activities, notwithstanding that any such losses were caused solely or partly by the negligence of any of the Releasees.
4. I/we do hereby agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Releasees from any and all damages or losses of any kind as a result of any and all claims, demands, causes of action of any kind whatsoever including those involving negligence on the part of any of the Releasees that may be made or initiated by, or on behalf of my/our child, arising out of or connected with the Assumed Risks as they relate to me/us and/or my/our child, the content or implementation of the Protocols as they relate to me/us and/or my/our child, and my/our child's preparation for and/or participation in any of the Activities.

- (a) that I/we understand that none of the Releasees assumes any responsibility whatsoever for my safety or the safety of my/our child during the course of any preparation for or participation in the aforesaid Activities;
- (b) that I/we will comply with the implementation of the Protocols and that any failure on my/our part (or on the part of my/our child) to comply with the Protocols and their implementation may have consequences (including without limitation a withdrawal of permission for me or my/our child to participate in an Activity or Activities) and could jeopardize relevant insurance coverage;
- (c) that I/we understand that the implementation of the Protocols may involve the collection, use and disclosure of personal information about me or my/our child and I consent to same;
- (d) that I/we have carefully read this ACKNOWLEDGEMENT, RELEASE, INDEMNITY, AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK that I/we fully understand same, and that I am/we are freely and voluntarily executing same;

Entering and Exiting Arena

Skater/Guardians, Coaches will be expected to follow the Entrance and Exit Protocol.

All Hespeler Skating Club Programs are in Rink#2. Please follow all signs when entering and exiting.

All doors will remain locked until 10 minutes before the scheduled ice time. If you do not arrive within that designated time the doors will be locked and you will not be able to enter.

Participants are required to use the designated markings outside the entrance when waiting to get in.

Health screening of all skaters, coaches and spectators will take place 10 minutes before entry into facility is permitted.

One door will be reserved for the entrance to the arena and one door will be for exiting.

Masks are REQUIRED for ALL skaters/guardians/coaches that will be entering the facility. Skaters and coaches must wear their masks until helmets are put on (Canskaters) or entering the ice surface for coaches and Star Skaters.

One parent or guardian per skater will be permitted as a spectator.

All spectators will be required to following seating guidelines and wear a mask or face covering at all times while in the arena.

Rink 2

Two groups of chairs will be set up. One will be set up outside dressing rooms 10, 11, and 12. The other will be set up in the lower foyer.

Arena staff will let the coach know which group of chairs the skaters will be using for their ice time.

All skaters are to remain seated until notice is given that the ice is ready. Skates, helmets etc are to be put on at their seats. Star Skaters will have a designated spot on the boards or near the entrance to the ice to put a bin that will be given to you. This will hold guards, tissue, phones, water bottles, masks, hand sanitizer etc.

Once the ice is ready, a coach will let you know when to proceed to the ice surface.

Skaters will enter the ice surface using their designated door. The lower foyer group will enter and exit the ice from the door near the stairs to the seats. The other group will enter the ice from the players box side of the rink.

Spectators will be allowed to watch from the top two rows of rink 2. Follow direction/indicator signs.

Both washrooms in the lower foyer will be open for use if needed.

There will be an isolation room. Dressing room 9 is set aside for any skater that becomes ill. If a skater has been sent to the isolation room, a coach will contact the parent/guardian to let them know and to ask them to come to this room. The coach will stay with the skaters until the parent/guardian has arrived.

After the session, skaters will put on their masks and return to their chair and skatebag. There will 10 minutes to quickly remove skates, collect belongings and follow signage to exit the arena through the upper level front left doors.
